On Saturday 4 February 2012 the Gippsland Speedway Motorcycle Club will hold it's annual Neil Street Cup Competition.

The competition is open to all Junior Riders and it is also a 'come and try day'. The aim of the Club is to promote responsible riding, making racing accessible and fun.

The Cup is named after world renowned rider Neil Street. Neil started riding in the early 1950s in Australia, venturing to England in 1952. He rode in both Europe and Australia until the mid 1970s.

After retiring from racing he became a mentor to many Australian riders who have pursued a speedway career, including Jason Crump, his grandson who won the world championships in 2004 and 2006. Sadly, Neil passed away in October of this year.

Neil maintained that speedway teaches discipline and safety. Riders are more able to look after themselves on the roads, either in a car or on a bike, when they are older.
